List of Materials - Year 4

_ 1 wide-spined folder with two rings (you can reuse one from the previous year)
_ 5 HB No. 2 charcoal pencils (suggestion: Staedtler brand)
_1 pencil sharpener
_ 2 white erasers
_ 1 set of coloured pencils (12 units)
_ 1 set of wax crayons (12 units)
_ 1 set of fine felt-tip pens for painting (12 units)
_ 2 pencil cases (one for writing materials and one for painting materials)
_ 1 pair of blunt-tipped scissors
_ 2 blue ballpoint pens, 1 black and 1 coloured (BIC medium brand - gel or fluorescent pens are not recommended)
_ 1 15 or 20 cm ruler (transparent and without figures)
_1 compass
_ 4 tubes of UHU glue stick (large size)
_1 UHU liquid glue
_ 5 A4 notebooks - 4 lined and 1 squared (with a sturdy, smooth cover, no rings, with margins)
_ 1 pad of coloured A4 card
_1 large piece of card (colour of your choice)
_ 1 refill of lined A4 sheets (with holes, margins and 100 mg thickness)
_ 1 A5 notebook with hard cover and smooth sheets (graphic diary) – you can reuse the one from the previous year
_ 1 fixed plastic sleeve folder – A4 size
_1 roll of painter's tape, 25 mm thick
_1 box of watercolours, 12 units (suggestion: Giotto)
_1 box of gouache - 12 units
_ 1 box of plasticine bars and a container with a lid to store them
_1 roll of plaster gauze (available at pharmacies)
_ Basic Portuguese Language Dictionary – Primary School
_ 1 sturdy box to store materials – such as a shoe box (adult size)
_ A pair of non-slip socks (for dance class)



- _ 1 pack of tissues (to bring daily in your backpack)
- _ 1 bottle of water (to keep in the classroom)
